

# The Spirit of Giving is alive & well at EHL

From humble beginnings, Jacques Tschumi founded EHL with a vision to provide exceptional hospitality education. Since its founding in 1893, the school's DNA has always been rooted in service to others.

Over the past 130 years, EHL has upheld a culture of giving back, with many examples of this ethos. Among these, the alumni association's contribution in the 1940s stands out. In 1942, after the Second World War, then-president Hermann Schmid worked with the alumni to donate the equivalent of 2.7 Million Swiss Francs\* to help the school reopen its doors and continue providing worldclass hospitality management training. This act of generosity saved the school and paved the way for its continued success. It exemplifies the determination and giving spirit of the EHL community, both past and present.

## New Scholarship for Master's Students

A small group of talented students began their Master's in Hospitality Management (MiHM) in September 2023 after being awarded a new scholarship from EHL Foundations for Scholarships and Honorary Loans, which allows them to pursue the 18-month course without any tuition fees. The scholarship is valued at 39,500 Swiss Francs per student and will be offered annually to selected Swiss students and foreign applicants who meet specific criteria. The main aim of this scholarship is to support the development of young talents and promote access to academic programs in the hospitality industry.
